

Introduction

I thank the many Dynamis students who have proved, supervised and edited these wonderful new remedies. Above all, I thank my wife, Camilla, who has overseen and participated in every aspect of this volume's preparation.

We have chosen the remedies for this book from the tree and animal kingdoms. These substances have a rich mythology and play important roles in many cultures. The Dynamis School provings of Olive and Yew tree have been completed by the Pacific yew and Willow. Salmon found its natural complement in the two Swans. *Brassica napus* is an older proving revisited.

The provings of *Cygnus columbianus bewicki* (Bewick swan) and *Salix fragilis* (Cracked Willow) were conducted by Penny Stirling. The proving of *Taxus brevifolia* (Pacific yew) has been conducted by Jake Kiakahe and Richard Pitt. We have included them due to their high quality and affinity to the Dynamis School provings.

Some of these remedies, such as Salmon, have been used extensively and confirmed by many clinical cases worldwide. Others, such as Taxus, have had little exposure and await further confirmation. All of these remedies will be completed only by our collected cures. We are always grateful to receive successful clinical cases.


