

INTRODUCTION

Many of the plants employed as remedies in homoeopathy may be described as strong poisons, menacing in their very appearance and nature, violent in their manner of growth and in their toxicity, but each of them in its individual characteristics separate and distinct.

TYOLOGY


The sensitive patient is :

FROM A PHYSICAL POINT OF VIEW :

- not particularly muscular - narrow thorax and large abdomen which is swollen and distended after meals making the stomach look somewhat like a frog's especially when lying down.
- the lower limbs are frail and varicosed.
- the face is yellowish, wrinkled, and appears to be older than the patient really is. The hair are prematurely grey. The eyes are alive and intelligent looking; this is in contrasts with the patient's otherwise physically run-down appearance.

Female patients are most often amenorrhoeic girls with small breasts, widows who are tormented by continence, or pre-menopausal women who have the same problems.

- Children look oldish; they wake up in a foul mood and are often anorexic. They have no self confidence, but are anxious to succeed in their studies at any cost. They are inclined to suffer from cephalgia because they work too hard at school, and are prone to facial tics.
