



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## **DRUG SENSITIVITY (INCLUDES REMEDY SENSITIVITY)**

Some people react very strongly to almost any drug they take, whether it is aspirin, antibiotics, or cold medicine. These same people are often sensitive to homeopathic remedies. The homeopathic remedies listed here can actually help the person become less hypersensitive to either allopathic or homeopathic medication. (See also Antibiotic Side Effects, Chemical Hypersensitivity, and Chemotherapy Side Effects.)

***Chamomilla***. Particularly helps the person who abuses narcotics (such as morphine, opium, or cocaine). Daily use of this remedy can help kick the habit or decrease the effects of quitting addictive drugs. This remedy is associated with the typical *Chamomilla* symptom picture of oversensitivity, thirstiness, whining, restlessness, impatience, and intolerance to being spoken to or interrupted. While similar to *Nux vomica* in many ways, *Chamomilla* is not associated with overindulgence in other areas (such as smoking, drinking alcohol and coffee, and overworking). The person who needs *Chamomilla* is sensitive to medications and drugs and reacts quickly to any of them. This is even true of homeopathic remedies, in that


the person overreacts to the remedies and has a more significant aggravation or proving.

*Nux vomica*. Very important remedy to help the side effects of drugs. This remedy is associated with addiction or dependence to medication (even herbal medication) and drugs. There may be an hypersensitivity to medications, with side effects being produced quickly. Narcotics, herbal medicines, and homeopathic remedies all can cause greater-than-typical reactions in a person who needs *Nux vomica*. The person who needs this remedy is the most susceptible to drug abuse. Often, drugs create a situation that aggravates the already hypersensitive, overreactive *Nux vomica* temperament.

*Phosphorus*. Associated with people who are very sensitive to medications and drugs because the reaction to any drug occurs quickly. Illegal drugs or prescribed medications may cause the person to become spacey, overly theatrical, or flamboyant. The person also fears taking too much and may ask the doctor to prescribe the bare minimum. This is even true of homeopathic remedies where the person will overreact to the remedies and have a more significant aggravation or proving.

*Pulsatilla*. The person taking *Pulsatilla* may be very sensitive and weepy, and seek consolation. Generally the person is not irritable but likes a lot of fuss and caring. The person may be susceptible to taking drugs because of feeling very vulnerable and insecure. These people may take illegal drugs due to peer pressure and often feel guilty and remorseful after indulging in drugs. If they have a bad reaction to drugs, they get very weepy and need people around them.

*Sulphur*. Useful for the person who develops rashes, diarrhea, and redness of the skin after taking drugs. There is often itching and the person has trouble keeping organized and maintaining good hygiene.
